Our surgery technicians are responsible for the care and treatment of stable, unstable/critically ill patients, monitoring hospitalized patients in the pre, intra, and post-operative periods, performing a wide variety of laboratory tests, treatments and nursing care, admitting and discharging patients, client communication and education, as well as answering technician calls. This position will entail working some weekends and holidays on an on-call basis.

Essential job duties include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Provide the highest quality of care to stable as well as hemodynamically unstable, critically ill patients in a surgery/anesthesia setting; evaluate patient status and response to stabilization and anesthetic/analgesic therapies
- 2. Collaborate with doctors and staff, in a respectful manner, to assist in formulating an optimal treatment plan
- 3. Assist in all areas of the hospital by performing patient assessments and treatments/procedures
- 4. Exhibit exemplary communication and compassionate, caring behavior with clients and patients
- 5. Proficiently perform technical duties to include, but not limited to:
 - medical math calculations and knowledge of pharmaceuticals
 - venipuncture, including venous catheter placement (peripheral and central), arterial blood sampling and catheter placement
 - intravenous fluid and blood transfusion administration
 - obtain radiographs
 - wide variety of laboratory assessments
 - indwelling urinary catheterization of both female and male canines and felines
 - sedation and anesthesia monitoring from induction to recovery in patients with an ASA status I-V
 - epidural and various local/nerve blockade administration

- aseptic preparation of patients prior to a variety of surgical procedures
- surgical suite/instrument use, care, and maintenance
- 6. Assist surgeons with minimal and advanced surgical procedures to include, but not limited to:
 - laparoscopic procedures (orthopedic, abdominal, thoracic)
 - orthopedic (fracture fixation, TPLOs, etc.)
 - soft tissue (mass excisions, urogenital, etc.)
 - abdominal (GI, splenectomies, etc.)
 - cardio-thoracic (thoracotomies, median sternotomies, etc.)
