The Veterinary Medical Center of the College of Veterinary Medicine at Michigan State University is seeking an LVT to join our Anesthesia Service. We pride ourselves in providing excellent medical care to our patients, and providing outstanding educational opportunities for our veterinary and veterinary technology students.

Position Summary: Provides patient care for ill and injured animals in the Anesthesia unit of the Veterinary Medical Center. This position works in both the Large and Small Animal clinic, instructs and demonstrates techniques to students, assists students and clinicians in their work, and maintains supplies, equipment and cleanliness of hospital areas. Working schedule is five, eight hour days, with overtime if necessary, eventually joining the emergency coverage rotation.

Minimum Qualifications: Knowledge normally acquired in the first two or three years in college, technical or vocational school in veterinary technology; six months to one year of related and progressively more responsible or expansive work experience in extensive patient care, surgery, anesthesia, drug-dosing, and sterilization; experience in the use of spreadsheet and word processing software; or an equivalent combination of education and experience; licensed as a veterinary technician with the state of Michigan or attainment of such certification within one year from date of employment.

Preferred Qualifications: Technicians with Veterinary Technician Specialty in Anesthesia/Analgesia (VTS)
