

## Licensed Veterinary Technician- Anesthesia

In this role, you will be a collaborative technical instructor to our DVM students, interns and residents which includes sharing your insights and experiences, offering care options while explaining the benefits and disadvantages of care options, and guiding the students in providing exceptional practical experience, along with providing quality patient care.

**What you will do:**

- Shape the future of veterinary care through collaboration and instruction of our diverse DVM students.
- Provide care by anesthetize and recover companion, equine and farm animal patients, which includes drug dosages and administration, equipment use and troubleshooting, patient care and all aspects of induction and monitoring.
- Maintain the service's computerized database, case records, anesthesia records, anesthesia charge records and drug records including controlled substances.
- Organize and schedule anesthesia cases and determine charges. Order, maintain and record drug inventory, including controlled substances, meeting legal and regulatory compliance records.
- As part of an academic teaching hospital, work with faculty to implement and/or collaborate with other service clinicians on clinical investigations conducted.

**What are the qualifications?**

- Associates degree in veterinary technology from an AVMA accredited institution with New York State licensure or eligibility to become licensed in NYS with 1-3 years of relevant experience in a veterinary hospital setting or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Interest in on-going career growth and advanced skill development.
