- Help with and take radiographs, especially pre- and post-procedurally
- Occasional late procedures or emergencies, which may extend out of hours. No on-call is required, but may be offered on a volunteer basis.

Skills that we would anticipate a successful candidate having are:

- Exceptional communications skills that can be tailored to both clients and team members
- A great attention to detail, strong work ethic and desire to learn more about anesthesia and physiology
- Proficient at scheduling; become familiar with procedures and average length of time involved with each procedure
- A coachable attitude that will lead to greater growth and development
- Flexible schedule
- Anesthesia experience required.
- Ability to use & troubleshoot anesthetic ventilators
- Experience with basic local anesthesia techniques (Eg: epidurals, testicular blocks, dental blocks). Experience with more advanced techniques such as nerve stimulator guided blocks is an asset but is not required.
- Experience with arterial sampling or placing arterial catheters is an asset, but training will be provided.

This is an excellent position for VTS Anesthesia certified technicians or those hoping to train and apply for this certification. Applicants must be a Registered Veterinary Technician with the OVTA.
