**VETERINARY ANESTHESIA AND SURGICAL TECHNICIAN:**

The Animal Surgical Clinic of the Rockies (ASC), a referral practice based in Lakewood, CO, is looking for a Veterinary Technician with a special interest in Small Animal Surgery and Anesthesia.

Our Surgical Practice focuses on Orthopedics (TPLO procedures, fracture repair, and joint surgery), Soft Tissue Surgery (intrathoracic, intraabdominal, and oncologic procedures) and Neurosurgery.

We operate four days a week, not including weekends or after-hours emergencies.

There are positions available for Level 1 Anesthesia/Surgery Technicians (\$25-30/h) and Level 2 Surgery Technicians (\$20-25/h).

Level 1 is an experienced Anesthesia/Surgery Technician that can run an Operating Room independently and efficiently without the Surgeon's assistance. Our Clinic operates under the standards of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons. Qualified Technicians would be able to apply for a management position that has a higher compensation after 1 year of employment.

Level 2 is an Anesthesia/Surgery Technician eager to learn and motivated to advance as a member of the Surgical Team. Qualified Technicians would be able to apply for a Level 1 Anesthesia/Surgery Technician position after 1 year of employment, with a higher compensation.

There are two types of Surgery Technicians at our Clinic: The Anesthetist and the Scrub Nurse. A Level 1 or a Level 2 Technician can work in either position.

The Anesthetist duties include preoperative evaluation of surgical patients, anesthesia drug calculations, IV catheter placement and fluid therapy, intubation and anesthesia monitoring, medical records keeping, and anesthesia recovery.

The Scrub Nurse duties include assisting with surgical consultations and rechecks, operating room set-up and ordering surgical supplies, prepping of surgical patients, assisting with surgical procedures, radiology, medical records keeping, sterilization of surgical equipment and discharge of surgical patients.

Compensation is above average, and benefits are offered after 90 days of employment.
