PVESC is looking for an anesthesia-only RVT. This role's primary case load will be neurology procedures (MRIs, surgeries, and CSF taps). While in neurology, you will be part of an experienced team consisting of 2-3 RVTs, 2-3 veterinary assistants, and 2 neurologists.

Outside of neurology, you will coordinate with specialists to create individualized drug protocols and anesthetic plans. You will work with a diverse patient population that will benefit from your advanced skills and talents. This role is ideal for a VTS in anesthesia and analgesia because your day is spent providing stellar anesthetic patient care. You achieve this while you work with doctors who rely on your anesthetic knowledge to make informed decisions and use advanced equipment to promote a safe/stress-free environment. Because your role is focused on anesthesia, your post-op/post-ax patient care is minimal.
