Job Description: Veterinary Surgical/Anesthesia Technician Southwest Florida Veterinary Specialists

A person(s) employed in the role of Veterinary Surgical Technician are expected to perform multifaceted tasks on a daily basis to ensure proper surgical day work flow and completion of appropriated cases. Tasks that are included in this job description, but not limited to, are those of the Veterinary Surgical Assistant, the Veterinary Surgical Technician/Scrub Nurse, developing anesthetic protocol, carrying out anesthetic protocol and induction, maintain anesthetized surgical patients, recover anesthetic patients to a minimum of extubation, be proficient with advanced invasive techniques (jugular catheters, urinary catheters, epidural analgesia, peripheral nerve blocks, maintenance of thoracostomy tube, maintenance of abdominal or peripheral drain systems), finalize appropriate drug log entries per case, enter charges into the Patient Visit List per case, formulate treatment sheets for postoperative care, oversee anesthetic case and report staff/team insufficiencies or inefficiencies to supervising doctor. Surgical doctor is to interpret laboratory work and diagnostics and clear results with anesthetist. It is also expected that the anesthetist per case keep track of inventory items used intraoperatively (i.e staplers, suture, implants) and appropriately charge and notate inventory.
