Job Duties:

- Obtain vitals and history of patient and note any signs of disease or illness in patient and discuss with doctor on duty.
- Place IV catheters, administering SQ, IM, and IV injections, perform venipuncture from Jugular, Saphenous and Cephalic veins.
- Accurately calculate drugs, CRI, and fluid rates as well as maintain lab equipment and other medical equipment.
- Confidently handle and restrain animals, that are sick or severely injured.
- Keep patient records updated throughout shift and makes sure if the patient is going home their invoice is up to date, instructions and medications are ready.
- Assist in medical and surgical procedures as well as prepping animals for procedures and or surgery. Monitor patients while under general anesthesia. Putting surgery notes in record.
- Perform diagnostic tests, e.g. bloodwork, urinalysis, and x-rays.
- Communicate with staff as well as clients about procedures and treatment of patient.
- Maintain a clean work area, have a team mentality!
- Knowledge of administrative and clerical procedures such as checking clients in as well as discharging them, able to take payments.
